# Looking Back 60 Years... Read on and give the class of 1960 a virtual reunion...

There were 147 members of the senior class, including 50 boys and 97 girls. <u>It was the largest class of seniors at the Fourth and Webster Streets' location.</u>

Father Daniel B. Powell, D.D. was the Rector of Holy Infancy Parish Father Joseph V. Sangmeister, J.C.D., LL.D. was the Principal Father John J. Nawn was the Vice-Principal and taught religion Father Vincent I. Cronin was the Athletic Director and taught religion and Latin

The Senior Play was "Young April", and the Christmas Pageant was performed. Mr. Charles C. Kropp was the Director of Dramatics

The Student Association elected officers were... **William Dwyer**, President; **Helen Zajacik**, VP; and **Robert Silvoy**, Secretary

**Susan Cunningham, Theresa Matus** and **Dorothy Keating** were page editors, and **William Gresho** and **James Link** were sports editors of the Tidings.


