Boys' Basketball

The boys' basketball team is currently 14-12 after a loss in the District XI 4A finals. Up next are the PIAA 4A playoffs beginning next week.

In the "Olden Days"

January 21, 1959—For the first time in six meetings, Bethlehem Catholic comes up with a victory over Allentown when the Golden Hawks get 28 points from **Bobby Csaszar '59** and 20 points from **Bob Bukvics '60** in a stunning 72-54 nonleague boys basketball victory at Bethlehem's Northeast Junior High School gym. – Morning Call 1/20/14

I wondered...

...how many boys' basketball games have been played in the 94 years since the school's inaugural 1926-1927 season. I did some homework over the years and found a treasure trove of information, primarily from the Morning Call and some other on-line newspapers. I actually got the results of the first four seasons, for 1926-27 through 1929-1930, from the school's Brown and Gold yearbooks...37 wins - 23 losses in the 60 games played.

I don't have any information for the 17 years between 1930-31 through 1946-47, although I found that the late Harry T. Tachovsky was the head coach during all or most of these years.

I do have information for the 73 seasons that followed, beginning with Frank Majczan's 1947-1948 season through this year... 996 wins – 857 losses in 1,853 games.

So, over 77 seasons, the school's record is 1,033 wins and 880 losses in 1,913 games. Cool, eh?

If any of you have any information from scrap-books or otherwise, could you please send them to the school or to me so we can get a complete picture?

Girls' Basketball

The girls' basketball team is now **27 – 0** and they just won their fourth straight Eastern Pennsylvania Conference and fourth straight District XI 4A title. Now they move on to the PIAA tournament on March 9.

Wrestling

The wrestling team finished the “team” portion of its season with a record of 16-3, placing 2nd in the East Penn Conference, 2nd in District XI 3A, and 3rd in the PIAA 3A tournament.

Eleven members advanced from the District XI 3A competition and sent seven wrestlers into the PIAA Class 3A Northeast Regional Wrestling finals on Saturday where three members won Regional finals: Tyler Kasak (106), Cole Handlovic (145), and Matt Lackman (152).
