
### May - The Month of Mary


You observe, the numbers decrease over time. This phenomenon would make for an interesting anthropologic study...



A 2- year commitment yields a 90% tax credit. So, a \$3500 donation to BECAHI costs you only \$350. It is even less if you can itemize your federal taxes! Use this link:

This popular program gives limited tax credits to PA taxpayers on a first-come, first-serve basis. Filling out the Joinder Form does not commit you to the program but saves your spot in the queue before alumni and parents from other Catholic schools. **Harry Mitchell '57,** has worked on every NASA Program from Mercury to Apollo to the Space Shuttle to the International Space Station!

After graduation from Villanova University and service in the U.S. Navy, Harry began his career in engineering, working on Sidewinder missiles with vacuum tubes, and secure voice devices and communication equipment for the government, using transistors and the very beginning of digital chips, at Philco, (now Philips), a pioneer in battery, radio, and television production.

He worked mostly communication programs and progressed through the ranks to Chief Engineer at a company that used modulation techniques to transmit information. 
