Jack Voss wrote... *"We didn't have a cafeteria so we would go somewhere for lunch. The guys I hung out with would go up the street to a small place where we would eat our bagged lunch and play the pinball until it was time to go back to school. I remember one day while we were gathered around the pinball, my back to the front door, one of the guys was talking about getting a free ticket to a basketball playoff game and wondered if he could get one from Father Cronin. To that, I remarked that Father Cronin would probably make his mother pay. Little did I realize that he was just coming through the door as we were talking. If I could have made myself invisible, I would have."*

The Blue Anchor was a place to hang out after school. Various boys and girls gathered to chat and have a soda. It was a place to socialize."

...I do remember that the nuns stopped teaching when a train would go by because it would be so noisy...

I remember that there was a swimming pool in the basement that was used for storage. I found it one day when I was told to go to the office for something that I did (but I don't remember why). Actually, I was a quiet, good kid in school, almost invisible. So, instead of going to the office, I went to the basement and walked around until the bell rang and class was over. Then I went to my next class. I thought I would get called to the office later once they found out I never went but never got called.

The rumor was that swimming was stopped after a student was under the water while a train went by and broke his eardrum. Don't know if that is true or not."

As reported last month, Bethlehem Catholic had a very successful fiscal year in annual giving. We practically doubled the Becahi Fund from last year's \$98,000, raising just over \$193,000. We surpassed our original goal of \$115,000 by over \$75,000. This amount does not include the \$150,000 given by John Feehan '82 and his wife Kathy, nor the \$112,000 raised by our Golden Gala. It also does not have the over \$420,000 we raised through the E.I.T.C. PA State Income Tax Program.

We thank every donor who continuously supports the academic work and growing needs of the newest generation of Golden Hawks. Our faculty appreciates your generosity in aiding them in their mission to provide our students with a first-rate Catholic educational experience. We welcomed many new donors this past year and hope you will consider joining them as we strive to reach new heights next year.
