On June 7, Bethlehem Catholic High School will **graduate forty-six students**. The events of the day open at 9:00A.M. with mass and Holy Communion **at Holy Infancy Church**, attended by the entire student body.

The evening exercises, beginning at 8:30P.M. will be presided over by the Reverend A. B. Caine, Rector of the high school. The guest speaker for the occasion is the Reverend John F. Keenan, D.D., C.M. superior of St. John's University, Brooklyn, N.Y.

William P. Hoffner and Dolores C. Fox have been chosen to deliver the graduation addresses. The musical scores for the evening, under the direction of William B. Rohs, include "Land of Hope and Glory," "Invitation to the Bells," "Commencement Song," and Luzzi's "Ave Maria."

I recently had an “e-mail conversation” with Brother Harold Hathaway, C.S.C. who taught religion and helped Brother Etienne with the scenery for South Pacific in the spring of 1966. I also reached out to Brother Richard Critz, C.S.C who is the Administrative Assistant at the Moreau Province Center in Austin, Texas to solicit his help. 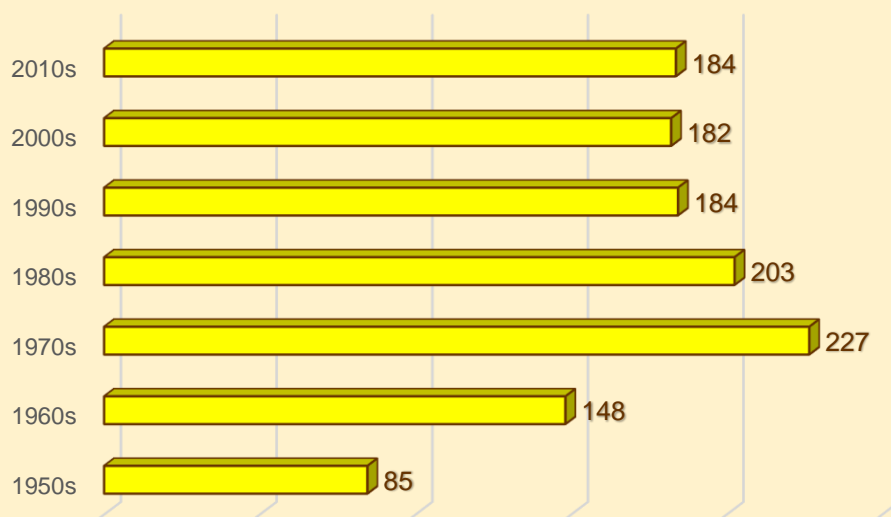

- **Brenna Magliochetti**, a junior, was named the Morning Call's Girls' Singles Tennis Player of the Year for 2017. Brenna won her second straight District XI Class 3A singles title and captured the PIAA Class 3A State singles title and is now 3rd on the all-time tennis wins record at Beca.
- **John Spagnola '75**, and a graduate of Yale University, was recently inducted into the National Football Foundation Lehigh Valley Chapter Hall of Fame. - The Class of 1969 was the first graduating class (and largest with 274 scholars) that attended the Dewberry and Madison Avenue location for four years.
- Class years 1968 (268), 1969 (274), 1970 (262), and 1971 (222) made up the largest number of students in Beca at the same time... ~1,026 (give or take a few).

Answers to last Month's Headscratchers...

- **In the 1950s**, there were an estimated 848 Becahi graduates. Those graduates came from 18 different parishes, and 66% of those graduates came from 5 parishes:
 - 156 from Holy Infancy
 - 114 from SS. Cyril and Methodius
 - 111 from St. Ursula
 - 107 from Holy Ghost, and
 - 76 from SS. Simon and Jude
- Q. What parish had the next highest number of graduates in the '50s?
▪ **A. St. John Capistrano with 64 graduates**
- **In the 1960s**, there number of graduates grew to 1,481 in this decade, and the number of contributing parishes grew to 25. During this time, the school moved from the Fourth and Webster Streets' location to Madison and Dewberry Avenues. Then, the top five parishes accounted for 52% of the graduates, including:
 - 197 from St. Ursula
 - 152 from SS. Cyril and Methodius
 - 143 from Holy Infancy
 - 139 from Holy Ghost, and
 - 137 from St. Anne
- Q. What parish had the next highest number of graduates in the '60s?
▪ **A. SS. Simon & Jude with 132 graduates**
