- Our class officers were Bernie Gillen, Betsy Horvath, Rick Jordan and Cindy Jubinsky.
- Bob Hinkle was the Band Director.
- We had 18 classmates on the football team, including Jeff Cassano who was a manager... Dick Butler was the head coach.
- We had 8 classmates on the boys’ basketball team, including Harry Hinnerschietz who was the manager... Paul Calvo was beginning his final year as head coach.
 - Aside: Senior Jim Chassar was the star of the team, and in this writer’s opinion, one of the best players to have worn the brown and gold uniform.
- The girls’ basketball team included 2 stars (Lisa and Maki) from our class, and was coached by Heidi Hydusik.
- We had 4 classmates (George, Rick, Tommy, and Frank) who made their mark on the wrestling team that was coached by Tony Iasiello.
- The Sno-Ball Dance featured “George and the Combinations”, although George’s last name wasn’t Fidmik or Kane.

Over the years, I have gone through the published yearbooks since 1950, and I figured out that our class contains the 1,000th boy to graduate since that time... and he is none other than “Captain’ **Pete Walsh**.

By the way, the 1,000th girl to graduate during this time was **Judy Donoso** from the class of '66.

About Tennis and... Back when we were young(er)...

Becahi just recently began its tennis season, and the girls are featured in the fall. The boys team plays in the spring. The head coach (for both the boys’ and girls’ teams) is George Harmanos and he is in his 42nd season as head coach for the girls’ squad, and six matches into the season his record is 453 – 195! His number one singles player is senior Brenna Magliochetti who is now in 2nd place in all-time singles wins and 3rd place all-time in wins.

Tennis began at Beca in the spring of 1969, for boys only at the time, and the coach was Brother Richard Arnold, C.S.C.. I reached out to **Chris Wright** a while back because he was a driving force behind the team’s introduction and to find out what he remembered about those early days...

“We started the tennis team... our junior year, and we played 12 matches in the spring of 1969 and again in 1970. I am somewhat embarrassed to say that I do not remember our team record. (That’s especially embarrassing because I do recall that I was 23-1 at

*number one singles, losing at Phillipsburg.) ... **Peter Gerra {'71}** and **Greg Benz {'71}** were core members of the team... (I don't know how it works these days, but we played four singles and two doubles matches, so you needed at least four players.)*

We practiced at the city courts on Illicks Mill Road, but all of our matches were "away." We weren't able to play in the District 11 championships then. I do recall that, in our match at William Allen, Peter and I beat the team that won the District 11 doubles title in 1970.

I also remember that the Globe-Times somehow thought my first name was "Christ," and that's how I was generally listed, which seemed blasphemous.

Thanks for the history lesson, Christ.
