### Boys Basketball's 1956/57 Season

The team finished the season 27-3 after losing in the Eastern PA Finals by 2 points Here are some highlights...

- Defeated Allentown Central Catholic HS, the 1957 PCIAA A Champion
- Defeated Fountain Hill HS three times, the 1957 PCIAA C Champion
- Lost 3 games by a total of 21 points Allen (18), Liberty (1), St. Vincent (2)
- Paul Calvo, Becahi Hall-of-Fame member, head coach
- Two 1,000-point scorers... Jack Egan '57 (1,140), Bob Bukvics '60 (1,485)
- 4<sup>th</sup> All-Time winning percentage in school history
- 2<sup>nd</sup> All-Time victories/season, and later,
