

100 Years of Becahi Sports in 2026

As part of the upcoming centennial celebration, I am attempting to recognize past achievements and milestones in Becahi team sport history. For example, the boys and the girls basketball teams, and the baseball team began with the 1926/27 school year. Other team sports, for the most part, were inaugurated after 1964 with the opening of the Dewberry and Madison Ave. school.

I need your help!

Boys Basketball History

Frank Majczan coached the 1947/48 and 1948/49 teams that captured the Philadelphia Suburban Catholic League Championship both seasons by winning over 88% of their games (45 out 51 games.) Frank also coached hundreds of future Becahi players in baseball, basketball, and football at St. Anne's.

In 1996, Frank, LU's Class of '44, was inducted into the Lehigh University Hall of Fame for his accomplishments in baseball, basketball, and football. "As a halfback on the football team, he was the recipient of the Archibald Johnston Cup and medal as the outstanding player on the 1943 team.

On the baseball diamond, Majczan played second base. He was the team's leading home run hitter and helped lead the Engineers to a 9-7 record in his senior year, the team's best in 10 years.

Perhaps Majczan's biggest impact came indoors on the basketball court. That he was elected captain said a lot about the respect he earned from his teammates. During the 1943-44 season, Majczan set a single-game Lehigh scoring record with 36 points in a game against Franklin & Marshall, a record that stood for 12 seasons. He also set a then-record at Lehigh for average points per game (17.93). Majczan scored 269 points in his Lehigh career, accounting for 41 percent of his team's total output.

Majczan was also named to the Associated Press All-Pennsylvania Basketball Team in 1942, 1943 and 1944." - LU Hall of Fame Bio

Frank passed away in March of 2020.

Charlie Wightman '59 sent an interesting observation that, in the rankings of the top scorers in basketball history, **Joe Sterlein '55** (6th) and **Jimmy Moroney '53** (8th),... lived directly across the street from each other in the 600 block of South Bergen St. in Fountain Hill.

Tom Seidenberger '66 sent me an interesting note relative to the 1965/66 basketball season, the second season in the "new" school. There were four 1,000 points plus players on the team that year, the late **Dan Dougherty '66, Tom Coyle '67, Jim Chassar '69,** and first year assistant coach **Bob Bukvics '60**, who supported Becahi Hall of Fame coach Paul Calvo. (5,088 points scored among the four former players). Good one, Tom. Thanks for that. And, BTW, this was *before* the 3-point era.

Girls Basketball History

Prior to that, the teams consisted of six members each, 2 forwards, 2 rovers and 2 defenders...and only the rovers were allowed to play on both sides of the court. Thank goodness for Title IX.


