

Celebrating the Class of 1963 with a Virtual 60th Reunion

The year 1962 ended with the passing of Becahi's Principal, Fr. Joseph Sangmeister, who led the school since 1948. He passed away on the feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8th.

There were many firsts that occurred during his stewardship... first Open House, first schoolwide student retreat; the yearbook Sceptre was introduced after decades of no "hard cover" almanac of class and school activities; the student newspaper Tibings was launched and became the source of student information for over 50 years, to mention a few.

Fr. William Hoffner '40, "a true son of Becahi," was appointed the ninth principal in school's history.

The school was preparing for the move to a new facility. The yearbook noted "We of Becahi – "the little school by the railroad tracks" – look forward with happiness and gratitude to the day the new Bethlehem Catholic opens spacious facilities to the boys and girls of Bethlehem."

"Oh my! You certainly will have room to move around, won't you?" was Mother Rose Ines's response to Sr. Rose Charlotte's boast of the new Becahi.

Fr. Vincent Cronin taught religion and Latin and was the Athletic Director.


