
Celebrating the Class of 1968 with a Virtual 55th Reunion

Greg Falkenbach wrote... "One recollection that I realized later was quite unique was at the beginning of our freshman year because the new school wasn't ready for occupancy until Dec. The old high school at 4th and Webster was too small to house the large freshmen class. So, they had to find temporary housing for the freshman class. My first 3 months were spent on the 3rd floor of Holy Ghost school. There were 3 classrooms of girls and one class split between boys and girls. I was in that class.

The unique thing about the Holy Ghost experience was our lunchtimes. We poured out of those 3rd floor classrooms into South Side Bethlehem where more times than not I ended up at the Valley Steak Shop. My memory has me walking into Valley Steak with the jukebox playing Roy Orbison 's Pretty Woman. In the back room, there was a whole wall of pin ball machines that could entertain you for the whole lunch period if you had enough nickels.

Quite a way to start high school! Hope it touches a few people who remember this as I do."

This is the second largest class to graduate from Becahi (behind the Class of '69), and the 42nd graduating class in the school's history. The school's student population at that time was 1,031... ('68, 270; '69, 276; '70, 263, '71, 222) ...the largest number of scholars under one roof in school history. The class spent half of their freshman year at the venerable school on Fourth and Webster streets.

The new school was "co-institutional" at that time; "boys on one side" (gym wing), "girls on the other" (auditorium wing).

Brother Etienne Cooper, C.S.C. was the Principal. Mother Michael Bernard, S.S.J. was the Vice-Principal.

Ada Hess was the school nurse.

Gloria Johnson and Susan Karlyn ran the main office.

Bill Haake kept the school's infrastructure running smoothly.

Jay Kardos, Irma Fertal, Mary Lawrence, Mary Keretz, Peggy Hildenberger Terry '34, and Ann Hamrick were the Betty Crockers of the cafeteria.

The school was new (including the floors) so, students were required to wear "hush puppies" or saddle shoes, (but no sneakers) so they wouldn't get scuff marks on the floors. Most shoes at that time had leather souls and/or rubber heels. Wearing (and getting caught) wearing these types of shoes got you detention.

There were classes in art, home economics, typing, adding machines, even Latin. There was a library!

We had to cover all our textbooks.

In 1978, Mr. "D" smiled when he showed me a French textbook he still used that had the same cover since 1968. The cover read "I love (to) French". It belonged to Lenny Righi. – Student Government President, and Valedictorian

Anne McCafferty and Steve Kraft were the Co-editors of Tibings. Jim McGovern and Kathy Carlin were Co-editors of Sceptre.

- There were over 100 members of the Glee Club, under the direction of Sr. Catharine.
- Music Man was the Spring musical in 1968, starring Larry Melley as Professor Hill and Diane Donches '70 as Marian, the librarian.
- The Sno-Ball dance was themed as an old-fashioned Christmas.
- The annual Christmas Assembly was a moving event before winter break.
- There was a Junior-Senior Ball held in the auditorium, transformed into a Hawaiian Holiday.



- Close to 100 students were members of the Marching Band and Majorettes under the direction of "Mr. Hinkle."
- There were over 15 different clubs for after-school activities. Clubs like
 - Future Teachers, Future Nurses, Great decisions, Forensics, Girls' Business Club, Boys' Business Club, Teens for Christian Action, Chess Club, Math Club, Model UN, Key Club, Varsity Club, Science Club, Folk Club, French Club, Golf Club (just kidding)
- Sports Activities included an undefeated football season, an East Penn League Championship for the girls' basketball team, and a state championship for the wrestling team. Check out the Sports Section of this newsletter for more in sports.


