Creating the Vision for the 100th Anniversary of Bethlehem Catholic 1926 – 2026

Here are a few ideas that were floated for our 100th Anniversary celebration year... (and I suggest that, in addition to the ideas, please include *HOW* the event(s) can be accomplished... we need volunteers!) Whaddya think of these? Let me know and I'll pass your comments and ideas along...

- Mass for all Becahi alums who graduated from the Fourth and Webster Street location at Holy Infancy Church (their original site for Baccalaureate mass) followed by a reception of some sort, at some location, on some designated Saturday or Sunday in 2026. Coming back to where it all began. The mass could be concelebrated by Becahi alumni clergy.
- Mass at the parish churches that the alums attended as elementary school children, followed by a reception of some sort, at some location, on some designated Saturday or Sunday in 2026. For example, a mass at St. Ursula's Church for the close to 900 students who belonged to this parish. Mass could be over two or three weekends. The mass could be concelebrated by Becahi alumni clergy.
- A mass for all those who graduated from the Dewberry and Madison Ave location in the auditorium followed by a reception of some sort, at some location, on some designated Saturdays or Sundays in 2025/26. The mass could be concelebrated by Becahi alumni clergy and those priests who taught at the school.
- Mass of appreciation for the Sisters of St. Joseph who served the school from the outset, and shaped the lives of thousands of students. Invite current and living sisters who served, alumnae who serve, along with those representatives from the motherhouse. The mass could be celebrated by the bishop and concelebrated by Becahi alumni clergy.
- One representative from each class to attend the class of 2026 graduation as part of the procession. The representative could be "voted" on by classmates, for example.
- Wall of Fame Induction for all undefeated and/or state championship teams in school history in 2025 and 2026. The ceremony could include all Wall of Fame members as well as general Becahi family. Football teams could be honored at a football game...basketball teams at basketball games, for example. Invite as many current and former coaches as possible.
- All-Alumni Reunions at the school...could be dances, sock hops, happy hours, guests at spring musicals, by decade, school location, etc.
 - Invite former cast members and crew from past musicals
- Mass at the school to invite and honor Becahi Veterans in November 2025 or 2026, concelebrated by Becahi alumni clergy.
- Collaborate with activities in Bethlehem/Lehigh Valley to tie to USA's 250th celebration

- The Rev. Msgr. John Rusek was the principal during the class's sophomore, junior and senior years.
 - (Br. Frederick McAuley, C.S.C. was the principal during their freshmen year.)
- Sister Eugene Joseph, S.S.J. was the Vice Principal
- The school transitioned from a co-institutional class configuration ("boys on one side, girls on the other") back to coeducation.
- The Barnabite Fathers joined the ranks of teachers as the Brothers of the Holy Cross exited.
- The Sisters of St. Joseph continued their commitment to serve the students.
- There were over 875 students at Beca during the class's senior year (231, 199, 236, 212)
 - There were 940 scholars at Becahi when they were freshmen
- Classes included business (typing, shorthand, etc.), home economics, fine arts, vo-tech
- Driver Education was taught by Mr. Lapp. I'm not kidding. Mr. David Lapp
- Student Council members included familiar-sounding Becahi names like Kathy Kelly, Larry Spagnola, Ed Redding and Patti O'Keefe
- Co-editors of the Tidings were Dave Klucsik and Mike Coulter
- Patti O'Keefe and Chris Connors were Co-editors of the Sceptre
- Band Officers were Mary Green, Rosemary Bortolotto '74, Paul Domyan, Patricia Green '75, Dave Klucsik and Maryanne Krenicky
- The Performing Arts in senior year included:
 - The play Our Girls, a farce-comedy in three acts;
 - Christmas Vespers
 - Fiorello! a 1960 Tony Award winner for best play, is a musical about New York City mayor Fiorello La Guardia, and tells the story of how La Guardia took on the Tammany Hall political machine.
 - ...completes the four years of musicals including My Fair Lady,
 Fiddler on the Roof and Hello Dolly, all under the direction of the late Sr. Catharine Immaculate, S.S.J.
- The National Honor Society's officers were Karen Kozo, Bobby Gallagher, Ellen O'Hare and Billy Sawyer
- There was even a Library! ...
 - Sr. Donatus, S.S.J. was the Librarian and the Library Aides were:
 - Susan Lilly '75, Susan McGouldrick '75, Susan Kammetler '76, M. Eckenrode, D. Lipp and Renee Illyes '74
- Commencement was Sunday, June 3rd (1973)

Rosina Bierbaum '70 Joins Prestigious National Society Founded by Benjamin Franklin!



For 280 years, the American Philosophical Society has recognized scholars across the world for "promoting useful knowledge." Founded by Benjamin Franklin in 1743, it's the oldest scholarly organization in the United States.

For nearly three centuries, less than 6,000 people have been appointed into the society, including Charles Darwin, Robert Frost, Louis Pasteur and Founding Fathers, such as Franklin, George

Washington, John Adams and Thomas Jefferson.

Rosina, the dean emerita in the University of Michigan School of Environmental Studies and Sustainability, joined the society's elite ranks this summer. She has been a science adviser to Presidents Bill Clinton, Barack Obama and briefly for George W. Bush.

After graduating from Boston College, Rosina earned her doctorate in evolutionary ecology in marine systems at Stony Brook University in New York. She found a fellowship in the early 1980s that brought her to Washington, D.C. working with the U.S. Congress on the issue of the day -- acid rain. - 1. If you were to describe Becahi in one sentence or one word, what would it be? A competitive high school rooted in the Catholic religion and tradition of its founders. TH Family/home IA
- 2. What is Becahi doing that you like?

In recent years, it has reached out to alumni more than ever and this is what will help build a financial future for students. TH

I think Beca has strong ties to the community and having students involved with different projects around the Lehigh Valley is so great. And I think the networking can only get better. IA

3. What are areas that Becahi could improve?

a. Following up with substantive donations could be helpful and encourage those to continue to donate. For example, The Class of 1970 contributed \$10,000 for the Francine Ferreira Scholarship, and those recipients send " thank yous" directly to donors, but the school office never gave an accounting of how the money might have been invested to yield continued income.

b. I suggest there be at least one or two members of the Board who are educated in finance and can assist with sound advice and follow-up.

c. Having worked at a Tier One, religious college preparatory school - St. Albans School for Boys - I can attest to the fact that alumni are the backbone of continued success of a school financially. TH

I think Beca should create an alumni/student networking system. This can connect alumni with students to look at schools and careers. When I went to college, I was always pushed something regarding my major from my professors, when I wanted to explore different options without being pressured into anything. Like talking to people in the actual field and what it's like for them without trying to constantly sell things to me. IA

4. Is/are there any things that Becahi is not currently providing that you believe you need or would like to see?

a. I would encourage Becahi to hire the absolute highest caliber of teacher with advanced degrees regardless of religious background. Competitive academics is the path to attracting the brightest students in addition to the athletes that are often touted, too. This includes hiring college counselors with vast experience with colleges, scholarships, and the use of social media. Success breeds success on all fronts.

b. I would encourage a course in resume building even if it is an "after-school" or virtual program. TH

Again, an Alumni/ student networking system. I know there is something similar Beca does have but it's lacking. IA

5. When people are looking for a recommendation for a quality high school education, do you refer them to Becahi? Why or why not?
