Sister Marie Matthew, S.S.J., taught French. Latin, and was in charge of Senior Play, Operetta, and girls' basketball.

Sister Regina Pacis, S.S.J., taught English and was in charge of the school's newspaper, Tibings.

Sister M. Rita Geraldine, S.S.J. taught English and national problems, was yearbook advisor, and moderator of Forensics.

Sister M. Rose Charlotte, S.S.J., taught typing, stenography, bookkeeping, office practice and was moderator of the Student Council

Sister M. St. Edmund, S.S.J. taught English and religion.

Sister M. William Teresa, S.S.J., taught math and oversaw the Cheerleaders and the stationery supplies.

The show must go on and they have continued to this day in the new Becahi at Madison and Dewberry Avenues. We, the class of '64, were the last class out of "the little school by the railroad tracks", on 4th and Webster Sts.

Sadly, within five years of graduation, we had already lost some of our class officers: President Tom Nolan, car crash; Vice Pres Peggy Fenerty, brain tumor, and, I think Marty Hildenberger, Treasurer had enlisted and was overseas; Bernie Repasch, Secretary, married Bobby Makosky and moved out of the area. Hence, no reunion planned.

Eventually in 1984, 20 years later, we had our first and last reunion at the Hungarian Catholic Club for Country Style Dinner with our Special Guest, Rev. Vincent I. Cronin."

The School on Fourth and Webster Streets' Legacy 1926 – 1964 (38 Years)

2,526 students graduated, including 874 (35%) boys and 1,652 (65%) girls.

- ★ 926 graduates (37%) (as of 2/15/24) are living ... estimated, as I could find.
- ★ 468 graduates (18%) were either a child of, and/or a parent of, a Becahi graduate.
- ★ 358 graduates served in the military.
- ★ 142 graduates served in the healthcare profession, including 118 nurses.
- ★ 75 graduates were education professionals.
- ★ 67 graduates followed a religious vocation.
- ★ 8 graduates became lawyers.
- ★ 10 graduates were selected as Becahi Distinguished Graduates.
- ★ 5 graduates were inducted into the Becahi Athletic Hall of Fame.
- ★ 1 graduate received 6 Emmy Awards for his work on screen.
- ★ 1 graduate was the Chief Scientist of the U.S. Marine Corps.
- ★ 1 graduate was Chief of Police for the City of Bethlehem.
- ★ 1 graduate was a three-term Bethlehem City Councilman.
- ★ 2 State Championship Basketball Teams (1960, 1962)
- ★ 1 Undefeated Football Team (1927)



Our Teachers Passings


✤ Sister Anne Charles, S.S.J., later Sister Mary E. Corbett, S.S.J., passed away on October 21, 2023.


