# The School on Fourth and Webster Streets' Legacy 1926 – 1964 (38 Years)

2,526 students graduated, including 874 (35%) boys and 1,652 (65%) girls.

- ★ 920 graduates (36%) (as of 3/31/24) are living ... estimated, as I could find.
- ★ 403 graduates (16%) were a parent of a future Becahi graduate.
- ★ 78 graduates were a child of a Becahi graduate.
- ★ 358 graduates served in the military.
- ★ 142 graduates served in the healthcare profession, including 118 nurses.
- ★ 75 graduates were education professionals.
- ★ 67 graduates pursued a religious vocation.
- ★ 8 graduates became lawyers.
- ★ 10 graduates were selected as Becahi Distinguished Graduates.
- ★ 5 graduates were inducted into the Becahi Athletic Hall of Fame.
- ★ 1 graduate received 6 Emmy Awards for his work.
- ★ 1 graduate became the Chief Scientist of the U.S. Marine Corps.
- ★ 1 graduate became a Becahi Principal
- ★ 1 graduate had a son who became a Becahi Principal
- ★ 1 graduate was the Chief of Police for the City of Bethlehem.
- ★ 1 graduate was a three-term Bethlehem City Councilman.
- ★ 2 State Championship Basketball Teams (1960, 1962)
- ★ 1 Undefeated Football Team (1927)

Yogi Eddinger '67 wrote... "You have challenged alums reading your Timings to think about teachers who had influenced them at BECAHI. It caused me to reflect on my four years of school. For me, without hesitation, it was Brother John Joseph Donnelly, CSC.

I limped through Becahi as a marginal student, only caring about basketball and not enough about academics. My grades accurately reflected my misplaced priorities. For some reason which, to this day, I know not why, Brother John Joseph took an interest in me and pushed me hard to study and try to succeed...

Brother John Joseph .. began to get me to think beyond playing hoops at the Boy's Club, to considering other options for my future, including college. I know he had to pray on that!

During my senior year at Becahi, he really pushed me hard. He went so far as to personally take me up to King's College in Wilkes-Barre to meet with the Dean of Admissions and spend the weekend with a freshman in Holy Cross Hall to experience college life. ...Come April, I received a letter from King's informing me of a complete miracle that I was accepted to enter the

school in the Fall. Without Brother John's efforts, that never would have happened. I took courses at Lehigh during the Summer, which was a condition of my acceptance.

I'll tell you; college was exceedingly difficult for me, and I didn't perform well the first year. I struggled to keep up. But Brother John... followed until he saw a light go off in my head that maybe I could actually do this. Change was hard, but I began to do just fine and ultimately graduated with a degree in Sociology.

After four years in the Navy, I soon developed expertise in Governmental Affairs. I went on to a fulfilling thirty-five year lobbying career, working my final 25 years representing in Olympia, Washington the 11,000 physician members of the Washington State Medical Association. It was really demanding working for 11,000 docs before the Legislature and Agencies! But I continued to feel Brother John's presence pushing me.

Reading Professor O'Boyle's Tibings every month shows that I am just one of the hundreds of success stories coming out of Bethlehem Catholic High School year after year! The caring and dedicated teachers and staff deserve a great amount of thanks for their efforts. I know there are many more stories like mine."

To this year's cast & crew, I say: Good Luck, Enjoy, & "BREAK A LEG"!!!"



#### The Class of 1969 - Becahi's Largest

This is the era of school history when there were over 1,000 students wandering walking the halls. Almost every student was related to another student in one way or



another as a sibling, a cousin, or a child of a Becahi graduate. Most students came from the Catholic elementary schools in Bethlehem, Fountain Hill and Hellertown. Everything seemed new.

The school was new, having been open for four years. This year's class was the first to spend all four years at Dewberry and Madison Avenues. The boys were on one side of the building and girls were on the other. They (we) found ways to travel across the complex to see our "friends on the other side" and get back within the few minutes allotted between classes. Ahhh...those were the days. We overcame so many obstacles...which probably lead to some of our

successes over the years.

It was the best of times...it was the worst best of times!

The high school musicals for the class of '69 included *The King and I, South Pacific, Music Man* and *Camelot.* The football, wrestling and basketball teams provided many of the male roles at the urging and pull of Sister Catharine Immaculate, SSJ. I remember Sister and Miss Jeanne, the choreographer, laughing at us, but at the same time turning our two left feet into coordinated left *AND* right steps.

World Cultures professor **Bob Bukvics '60** said... "I'm from the old school. I still believe I'm right and you're wrong" – Tibings Vol XVII, No.3, February 1969

It was the best of times...it was the best of times!

Anyway, I digress.

The class was comprised of angels from 21 different parishes in the area, with 5 of those parishes contributing 69% of the class members including...

St. Anne's (51 students) Notre Dame (40)

St. Ursula's (32) SS. Simon and Jude (28)

Holy Ghost and SS. Cyril and Methodius (19 each)

There were 276 scholars in this class... 150 (54%) ladies and 126 boys. Twenty-two girls (15%) had the first name of Mary...


