# Smoke Reported in School Remote Learning to Close Out the School Year.

Firefighters were called to the school on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Smoke was reported around 6am. According to emergency dispatchers.

Bethlehem Catholic High School, which had hoped to resume in-person classes on Tuesday, May 21, made the decision to finish the 2023-2024 school year virtually out of an abundance of caution for the health and safety of the students and staff, according to a news release from the Diocese of Allentown.

The diocese says continued investigation into the fire has revealed odor damage due to the smoke in the plenum space, which is the air space above the drop ceiling in the senior and junior hallways of the building.

The diocese says the current plan is to hold final exams and graduation ceremonies in person. The school is currently exploring different options to make this possible. – Morning Call

### Did you know?

In 1861, Holy Infancy Church was established as a parish in South Bethlehem and was the first Catholic church in Northampton County.



**John Nolan '67** wrote "... my father [Dan] graduated from Holy Infancy in 1918 [pre-Bethlehem Catholic High School days] and my two brothers, **Dan '62** and **Tom '64** and sister **Mary '61**, and I all graduated from BCHS.

Holy Infancy Parish built BCHS on the former grounds of the Temperance Hall. I think the Temperance Society donated the property to the parish for the construction of the high school which was run by Holy Infancy until the diocese took over in the 1950's. The Temperance Society began to fade away after the Prohibition act of 1920 and lingered on for a few years after the repeal of prohibition in 1933, before disappearing altogether. I am not sure of the exact dates for the end of the Temperance Society. But in its day, it played a significant role for the people of Bethlehem.

### **Some Bethlehem History**

**Street Names** (Source: Jason Rehm, Bethlehem Press, 7/14/20)

Nitschman Street – Bishop David Nitschman (1696-1772), founder of Bethlehem, purchased 500 acres of land on the confluence of the Monocacy Creek and Lehigh River. His uncle, Father (David) Nitschman (1676-1758) cut the first tree for the First House of Bethlehem.

Garrison Street – This street bears the name of Nicholas Garrison (1701-1781), the famous captain of the Moravian ships "The Little Strength" and "The Irene", on whose voyages brought hundreds of Moravians to the new world.

Ettwein Street – Named in honor of Bishop John Ettwein (1721-1802), whose strong leadership and non-combative beliefs were essential to Bethlehem during the trying times of the Revolutionary War. Ettwein was the representative of the Moravian Church before the Continental Congress, and with his strong command of English, he was able to preach to troops and minister to the wounded in the hospital.
