
As I wrote last year at this time, "All year long we reflected on our school's history and celebrated the "good news" of her graduates in the \mathfrak{Things} . Christmas is a time of spiritual reflection, a season of expectation, and a time to celebrate God's love for the world through the birth of the Christ Child."

So, as we move through the season, let's spend a few minutes each day remembering and reflecting on the gifts we have been given. One way to help in this reflection is to light the Advent Candles.

The Advent Candles

The advent candles correspond to the themes of each week of advent. We begin lighting a candle on the fourth Sunday before Christmas, and we light another candle each subsequent Sunday.

- ^a The first candle symbolizes hope and is called the **"Prophet's Candle."** The prophets of the Old Testament, especially Isaiah, waited in hope for the Messiah's arrival.
- ⁶ The second candle represents faith and is called "Bethlehem's Candle." Micah had foretold that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem, which is also the birthplace of King David... (and most of Beca's graduates).
- The third candle symbolizes joy and is called the "Shepherd's Candle." To the shepherd's great joy, the angels announced that Jesus came for humble, unimportant people like them, too. In liturgy, the color rose signifies joy. Remember? Gaudete Sunday?
- The fourth candle represents peace and is called the "Angel's Candle." The angels announced that Jesus came to bring peace--He came to bring people close to God and to each other again.

Look what I found! 99 Years Ago >

In December 1925, parishioners of Holy Infancy Church began a campaign to raise a fund of \$50,000 to furnish and equip a new Roman Catholic high school for Bethlehem, which was under construction at Fourth and Websters streets.

There was no solicitation of funds. The parishioners merely gathered each Sunday evening in the parish hall where they voluntarily made their contribution and pledges. Six Sunday night meetings were scheduled.

The Rev. Charles E. Bowles was the pastor, and the Reverends Joseph Duross and John T. Morton were assistants. – Morning Call 11/15/1925

By the way,

\$50,000 in 1925 is equivalent to over \$900,000 today.

HOLY INFANCY DRIVE OPENS THIS EVENING

\$50,000 Will Be Raised to Equip New High School

This evening the parishoners of the Church of the Holy Infancy, Bethlehem, will inaugurate a campaign to raise \$60,000 to be devoted to the fund for equipping and furnishing of the new Roman Catholic High school now being erected on the site of the former Temperance Hall. The campaign will be directed by D. B. O'Loughlin, of Philadelphia. An organization of parishoners has been chosen to aid Mr. O'Loughlin in the work.

To really celebrate the family of Becahi as it closes in on its 100th Anniversary in 2026, I am endeavoring to recognize those graduates who have family-generational ties to the school, whether it be through marriage or birth. Over the past several months, the names of graduates between 1927 and 1949 who are parents, grandparents, and/or great grandparents have been noted. Marriage to a Becahi graduate was also noted as was any of their descendants who later graduated from Beca.

I thought I'd give you a snapshot of what I have found (so far).

In the 1920s, (1927-1929), there were 56 graduates

11 became parents of 23 future graduates

6 became grandparents to 14 future graduates, and

2 became great grandparents to 4 future graduates

5 married a Becahi graduate

In the 1930s, there were 497 graduates

108 became parents of 249 future graduates

37 became grandparents to 92 future graduates, and

3 became great grandparents to 6 future graduates

47 married a Becahi graduate

In the 1940s, there were 596 graduates

149 became parents of 404 future graduates

32 became grandparents to 89 future graduates.

64 married a Becahi graduate

Between 1927 and 1949, there were 1,149 graduates

★ 268 became parents of 676 future graduates

★ 52 became grandparents of 194 future graduates

***** 5 became great grandparents of 10 future graduates

★ 881 Future graduates

• That's 76% of the 1,149 alums who graduated in those years!

★ 116 (10%) married a Becahi graduate




