Cardinal Dougherty to Attend Formal Dedicatory Exercise in Fall – Event Marks Important Epoch in Parish History

"A splendid gathering including many non-Catholics and visitors from other parishes, were in



attendance at the laying of the cornerstone of the new Bethlehem Catholic High School, located at the northwest corner of Fourth and Webster streets, formerly the site of the Temperance Hall, on Sunday afternoon. The event marked an important epoch in the history of the old Holy Infancy parish, whose origin dates back to 1868, the oldest of the nine Catholic parishes in the City of Bethlehem. The cornerstone ceremonies, very brief, were in charge of the parish clergy of Holy Infancy, Rev. Charles E. Bowles, rector, and Rev. Joseph P. Duross and Rev. John T. Morton,

13,000 HAPPY CHILDREN WEND WAY TO SCHOOLS

Bright Sunny Day Marks Opening of the 1926-27 Term

Approximately 13,000 children of school age in Bethlehem, Tuesday morning assembled at their respective school buildings, to receive promotions and resume their studies for the new term. The bright, sunny morning added much to the delight of the children of the public and parochial schools as they hurried on their way to be on time at the call of the final bell.

The resumption of school activities in the city was marked by the opening of the new Bethlehem Catholic High School, erected the past summer at Fourth and Webster streets, on the former site of the Holy Infancy Temperance Society. The enrollment for the first day was much gratifying to the director, Rev. Joseph P. Duross, assistant rector of the Church of the Holy Infancy, which is under the supervision of the Rev. John J. Bonner, D. D., superintendent of Catholic Schools in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

One hundred and twenty-two students enrolled the opening day and this number will be somewhat increased in the next few days. The opening was featured with addresses by Rev. Charles E. Bowles, pastor of the Church of the Holy Infancy and Father Duross.

The Holy Infancy Parochial school resumed activities following the celebration of a solemn high mass in the Church of the Holy Infancy at 8 o'clock by Rev. Joseph P. Duross. The number of children present on the opening day was 405.

The Saints Cyrillus and Methodius Parochial school opened with an attendance of 700 pupils; St. John's, \$50; Holy Ghost, 619; St. Ursula, Fountain Hill, 230; Saint Simon and Jude, 225; St. John's Lutheran, 240.

Between 500 and 600 children resumed their studies on Tuesday morning at the Fountain Hill Borough schools. The Junior High school is well filled with students.






Shaping the Future

The over eleven thousand alumni members of the school community are most interested in the strategy that addresses shaping the future of the enrollment numbers.


The 2 charts below track the class sizes of graduates






