Time-sharing meant togetherness, not computers; a chip was a piece of wood; hardware was hardware and software was not a word; pizza, Cheerios, frozen food, instant coffee and McDonald's were unheard of...We thought fast food was what you ate during Lent...there were 5 & 10 cent stores where you could actually buy things for five and ten cents. For just one nickel, you could ride the subway or ferry, or make a phone call, or buy a Coke, or buy enough stamps to mail one letter and two post cards. You could buy a Chevy coupe for \$659, but who could afford that in 1938? Nobody. A pity, too, because gas was 11 cents a gallon..."






