A Look Back at Becahi Sports History for March

March 7th, 1970 - George Fidmik '70 and Tom Sculley '70 each win their third individual title and three other Golden Hawks, Billy Kametz '71, Mike Kozo '71 and Pat **Sculley '73**, win crowns to lead Becahi to their third PCIAA wrestling title.

March 8th, 1960 – Bob Bukvics '60 becomes Beca's all-time leading scorer, scoring 16 points to hike his career mark to 1,403 in the Golden Hawks 88-55 win over Shenandoah Catholic in the Philadelphia Diocesan Class B title game.

March 17th, 1973 – **Pat Sculley '73** became the first non-public school state wrestling champion.

March 18th, 1983 – **Duane Peoples '83** beat Penn Hill's Kevin Haselrig 5-3 in the PIAA Class 3A quarterfinals to become the winningest wrestler in state history at that time.
