The head coach will be responsible for all aspects of the boys basketball program while supporting the mission and values of Bethlehem Catholic High School.

The successful candidate will foster athletic excellence, sportsmanship, and leadership while building strong relationships with student-athletes, families, feeder programs, and the broader Bethlehem Catholic community. The coach will work closely with the athletic department to ensure the program reflects the tradition, integrity, and educational mission of Bethlehem Catholic.

Primary Responsibilities

Program Leadership

- Organize, supervise, and administer all aspects of the boys basketball program including varsity, junior varsity, and developmental levels.
- Develop and implement a comprehensive program philosophy consistent with the mission and values of Bethlehem Catholic High School.
- Establish a culture of discipline, accountability, teamwork, and sportsmanship.
- Maintain high standards of conduct for student-athletes both on and off the court.

Player Development

- Plan and conduct organized, structured practices focused on skill development, fundamentals, conditioning, and team strategy.
- Evaluate student-athletes and provide opportunities for growth and development at all levels of the program.
- Promote academic success and ensure student-athletes maintain eligibility standards.
- Encourage leadership and character development among student-athletes.



Game Management

- Prepare the team for competition through scouting, game preparation, and strategic planning.
- Provide leadership and supervision during games, tournaments, and team travel.
- Promote sportsmanship and respect for opponents, officials, and the game.

Staff Leadership

- Work with AD to hire, supervise, and mentor assistant coaches.
- Conduct regular meetings with coaching staff to ensure consistent program philosophy and player development.
- Work collaboratively with athletic trainers, strength coaches, and school administration.

Program Development & Community Engagement

- Build and maintain strong relationships with Little Hawk and Junior Hawk basketball programs to strengthen the program pipeline.
- Actively support and collaborate with Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) basketball programs and local parish athletic programs.
- Attend Little Hawk & CYO basketball events and clinics to develop relationships with future student-athletes and families.
- Promote a unified basketball culture from youth programs through the high school level.

Program Promotion

- Represent Bethlehem Catholic basketball with professionalism in the school and local community.
- Promote the program through youth camps, clinics, and community outreach.
- Work collaboratively with the athletic department to highlight team and individual accomplishments.



Administrative Duties

- Comply with all policies set forth by the school administration, athletic department, and governing athletic organizations – Eastern Pennsylvania Conference, District XI & PIAA
- Manage equipment, uniforms, and program inventory.
- Assist with scheduling contests, coordinating transportation, and program logistics.
- Maintain communication with players, parents, and administration regarding program expectations.

Character and Mission Alignment

- Serve as a positive role model who reflects the Catholic values and educational mission of Bethlehem Catholic High School.
- Emphasize sportsmanship, integrity, humility, and respect.
- Promote service, leadership, and community involvement among student-athletes.

Qualifications

- Previous high school or collegiate basketball coaching experience
- Strong knowledge of basketball fundamentals, strategy, and player development
- Demonstrated ability to lead and mentor student-athletes
- Ability to build relationships with youth programs and community organizations
- Strong organizational and communication skills
- Commitment to the mission and values of a Catholic educational institution
